



Title	Part Time Tuition Policy

This policy is designed for High School students who are not enrolled full time. There is no equivalent discount for elementary students.

1. Part-time registration is defined as 3 or fewer 4-credit courses over the course of the school year. Part-time tuition is set at 50% of full tuition.
2. Full-time registration be defined as 3.5 courses or more over the school year and full tuition rate applies.
3. Students who register as full-time students (3.5 or more courses) and then drop to 3 or fewer courses in a school year, pay 75% of the tuition rate.
4. Full-time students receive priority registration in all courses.
5. As long as students are in good standing, they are eligible for participation in PCS-sponsored extra-curricular activities, such as on sports teams, with performing arts groups, on school trips, or in graduation ceremonies.
6. Part-time students may be charged additional fees to participate in PCS-sponsored extracurricular activities, such as on sports teams, with performing arts groups, or on school trips.
7. For graduating Grade 12 part-time students, an additional graduation fee of \$250 will also apply and will include the administration of Career-Life Connections, Capstone and participation in the graduation ceremony.
8. This policy cannot be used in combination with multi-student family discounts. In the case of multi-child PCS families, total family tuition would equal the total of the regular student fees for any full-time students and the part time fees for any part time students (or the regular multi student family rate, whichever is less).
